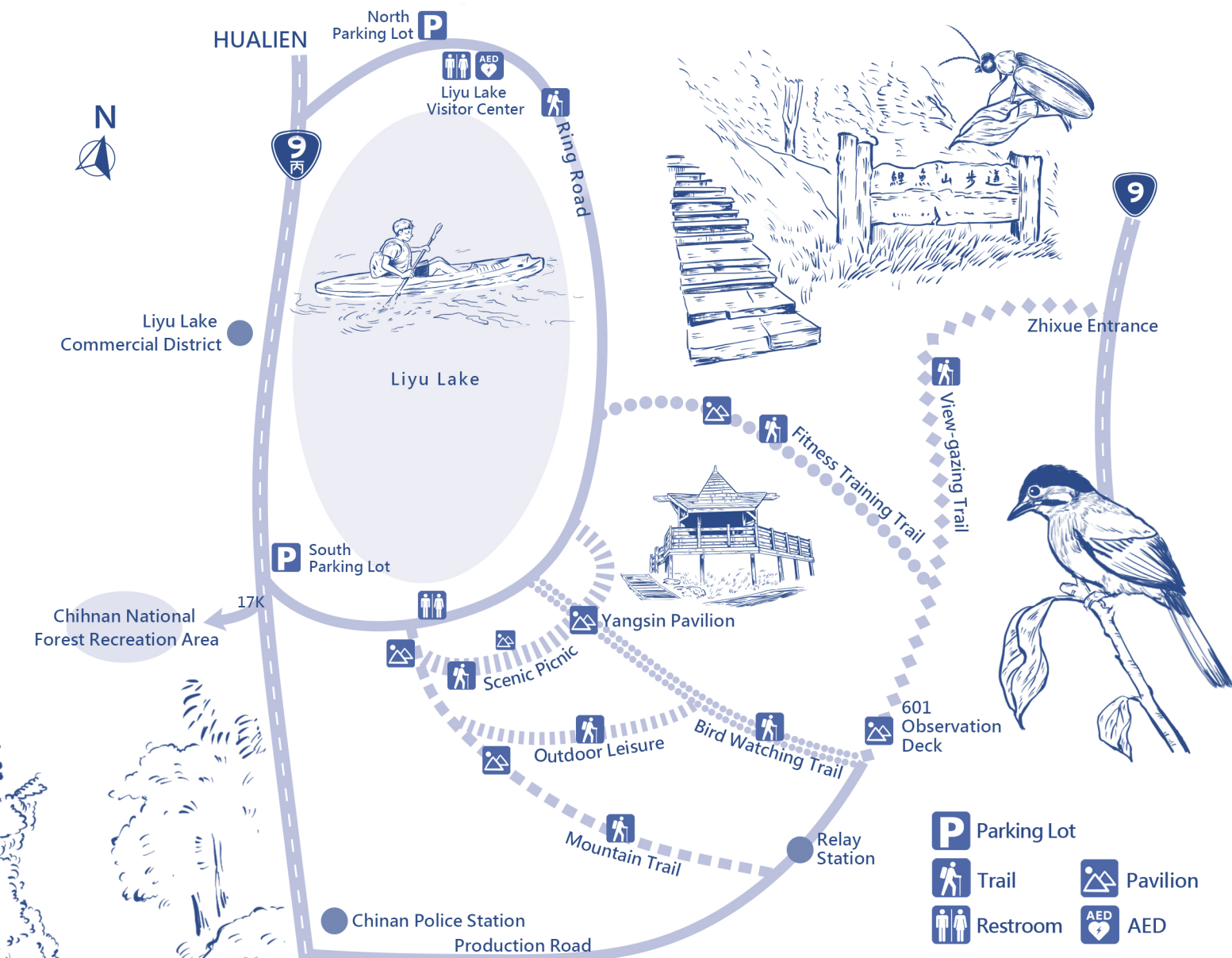
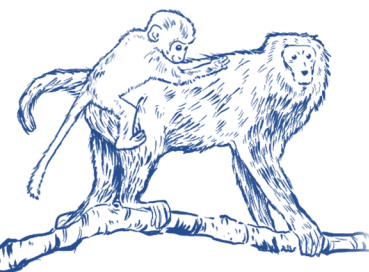


Chinan National Forest Recreation Area Liyu Mountain Trail Network Map

Chinan National Forest Recreation Area is the only forest park in Taiwan crossed by a public highway. It is located along Provincial Highway 9C, on the eastern side of Liyu Lake. A walk along the lakeside loop road brings you to several trail entrances. You can choose from the Mountain Trail, Bird watching Trail, Scenic Picnic Trail, or Fitness Training Trail. These trails lead to Liyu Mountain, one of Taiwan's Minor 100 Peaks, standing at 601 meters. The round-trip hike takes about two hours and features low-elevation forest scenery, along with occasional sightings of species such as the Maroon Oriole and Fairy Pitta. Visitors can adjust their route according to the time available and their physical condition.
