The Century-old Forest Railway An Enriching Experience

The Alishan Forest Railway began operations in 1912 and boasts over a century of rich history. During the Japanese colonial period, the Taiwan Governor-General's Office constructed this railway to transport timber from the Alishan forest region, which became a crucial transportation artery for the Chiayi mountainous area, responsible for moving residents, travelers, and goods along its route, thereby spurring urban development in Chiayi through forestry.

You can ride on the railway that has evolved with the times to leisurely explore the scenic route. Experience the vibrant charm of mountain villages, explore the stations hidden in the woods, admire the changing forest scenery through the windows, appreciate the engineering marvel of the mountain railway, and fully immerse in the rich cultural and precious landscapes of the Alishan Forest Railway.

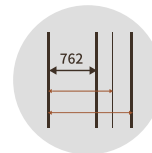
The Forest Railway Cultural Heritage

1 Dulishan spiral loops



The rail encircles Dulishan three times and ascends for 200 meters, guiding the train to leave through the "8" shaped route, which allows travelers to see the same train passing by three times while standing at the same location.

2 762mm Narrow Gauge Train



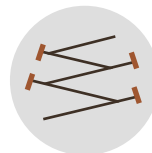
Using a narrow gauge and lightweight carriages to optimize the train's climbs and turns, this railway is the highest narrow-gauge mountain railway in Asia.

3 180-degree Horseshoe Curve



The 180-degree large curves increase the climbing distance, thereby reducing the gradient.

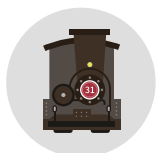
4 The Zigzagging Alishan Train



Due to the limited space, the railway employs a zigzag track, allowing the train to ascend by repeatedly moving forward and backward.

5 The Best Climber: SHAY Steam Locomotives

Made in the USA, the Shay locomotives have been renowned for their vertical cylinders and exceptionally strong climbing capabilities. They were introduced since the railway's inception.



Alishan was the leader of the three major forest sites in Taiwan. Riding the forest railway offers a comprehensive view of Taiwan's historical forestry development, from the timber collection facilities and Tree Spirit Pagoda in Alishan to the sawmill and Japanese-style wooden dormitory cluster in Chiayi City, all of which bear witness to Taiwan's history in forestry.

We preserve the railway's cultural heritage dynamically by restoring steam locomotives for operation and redesigning the cypress carriages, the new Formosensis, and renewed Vivid Express, as well as opening up the Loco Shed Park and the Grand Alishan School, providing diverse opportunities to engage with railway culture and relive the glory of the forest railway's past.

Combining the features of both industrial railways and mountain railways, our journey starts from Chiayi Station and ascends over 2,000 meters to the Alishan Forest Recreation Area. Visitors can observe how the forest scenery changes throughout the ascend while looking for surprising encounters with rare and adorable wildlife.

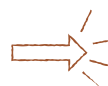


Explore Mountain Villages!

Visiting the Forest Railway

Zhuqi

Starting Point of the Mountain Segment

This quaint wooden station marks the transition from the flatlands to the mountain segment and was once the bustling hub for travelers and goods. The surrounding weigh station, coal stage, triangle, and waterside park are popular hotpots to experience railway culture.

Nostalgic Grocery Store

Next to the station is the Xinmao Grocery Store, a century-old establishment that provides mailing service to residents and travelers, offering the warmest welcome.

Legendary Old Street

In the past, trains would meet here around noon to replenish water and coal, and the station housed a garage for maintenance and inspection, making it the largest mid-route station on the forest railway. In addition to railway culture, natural scenery, ancient trails, and local delicacies, the strong sense of community in this mountain town is particularly captivating.

First Switchback and Second Switchback

Alishan Zigzag Railway

From Pingzhena to Erwanping, the straight-line distance is only a few hundred meters, but the elevation difference is nearly 300 meters. To overcome the terrain, the railway employs a zigzag route winding over six kilometers. The two reversal points are known as the First Switchback and Second Switchback.

Duolin

The Hidden Homeland of the Tsou People

This is the most secluded station along the entire line, once named "Duoluoyan" in Tsou, which means dense forest. The station is decorated with Tsou paintings, and a one-hour walk leads to the Deenyana Tribe.

This crossroads, once an ancient path and the passage to surrounding tribes, is now the closest point between the railway and the Alishan Highway. Disembark and visit stores opened by returning youth, where you can savor dishes prepared with fresh local ingredients.

Sunset Sea of Clouds Panorama

Named for its broad terrain, this is the best spot to view the majestic Tashan. When the sea of clouds fills the valley and the sun sets slowly, the magnificent scene is truly breathtaking.

Roaming through Goldenrain Tree Path

Surrounded by a station master's dormitory, tobacco buildings, and the Manzhu Cycling Trail, this picturesque rural sight is ideal for cycling and chasing the little train.



As the starting point of the Dulishan spiral route, one can look up from Zhangnaoliao and see the train ascending repeatedly. This station is also one of the rare "switchback stations" in Taiwan, where the train must reverse to enter the station. Zhangnaoliao Station is the starting point of the Dulishan Mountain National Trail, making it a popular choice for combining train rides and hiking activities.

● To accommodate sunrise times, the Zhushan line train schedule is announced on the official website and Alishan Station at 16:30 the previous day. Besides online booking, tickets can also be purchased in advance at Chiayi Station, Beimen Station, Fenqihu Station, and 2F of Alishan Station to avoid ticket sold-outs.

Ticket Passes

One-Day Pass: NT\$400 for adults / NT\$200 for children

Two-Day Pass: NT\$500 for adults / NT\$250 for children

Passes can be purchased at Alishan Station the day before or on the day of the trip

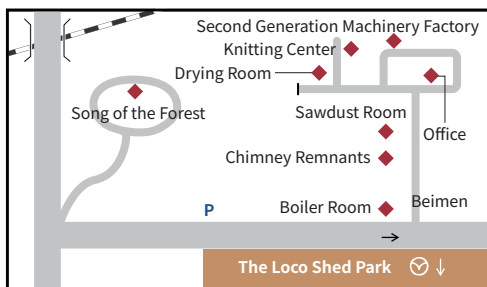
Song of the Forest

Designed with the vision of towering sacred trees and Alishan railway tracks, while also inspired by the Kuba structures and bamboo weaving of the Tsou people, it forms a landmark of the forestry cultural park's landscape.

Completed in 1914, this was the largest government-run timber industry park in Asia at the time. Many historical buildings and relics remain preserved, along with extensive grassland that was once a cypress pond, providing a rare cultural and tranquil setting in Chiayi City.

Comprising 31 employee dormitories from the Alishan timber industry in the Japanese colonial era, these structures have been restored using the original materials and construction art. Today, it is the largest and most complete Japanese-style official residence complex in Taiwan, and a must-visit in Chiayi.

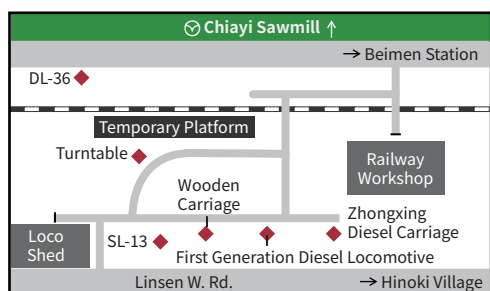

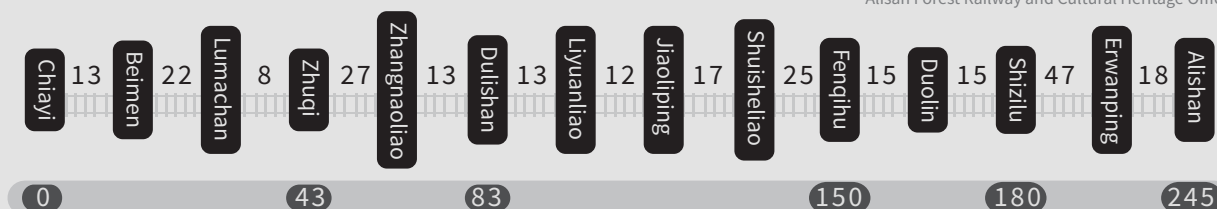
